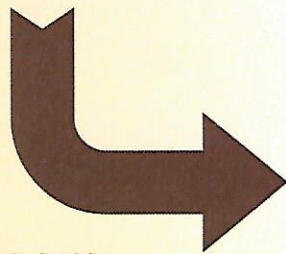

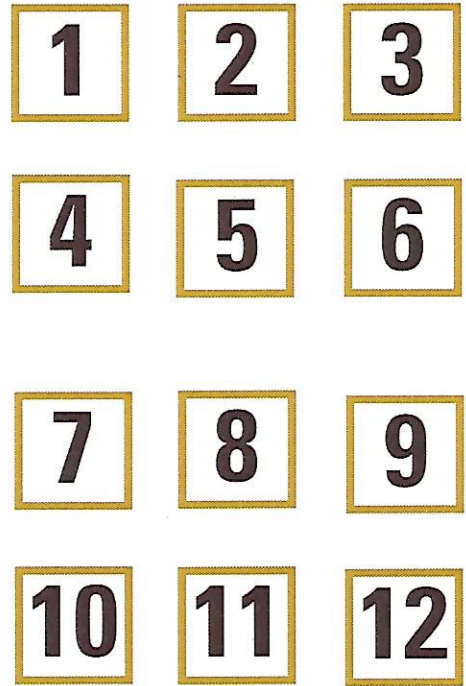
## How To Participate
